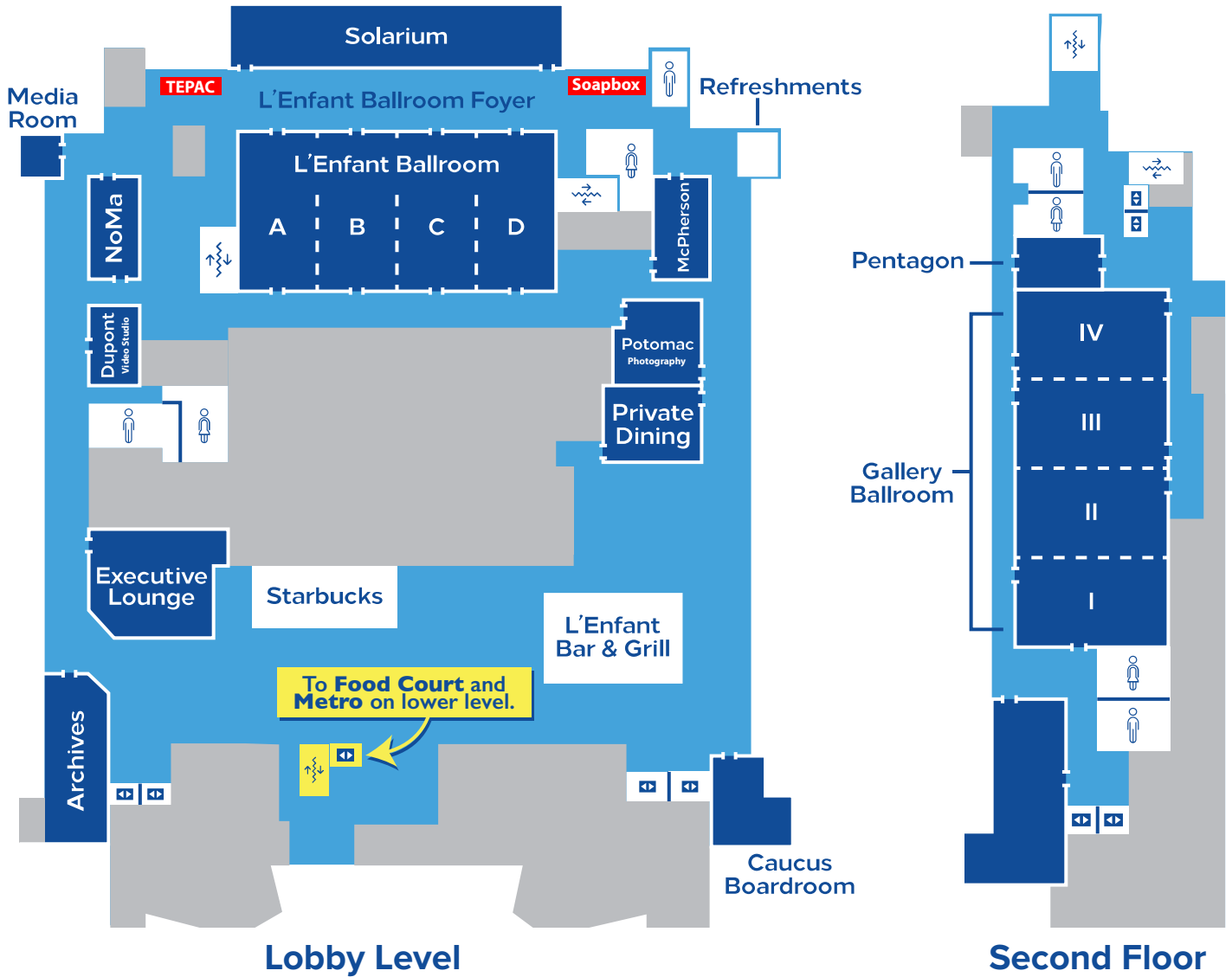
### \*Getting to Capitol Hill:
