Dedicated federal employees serve the American public from coast to coast. The federal employees who live in work in Nebraska are part of the 85% of federal workers who live and work outside of Washington D.C.

In 2024 there were an estimated **10,325** federal employees living in the state, representing **2.1%** of the Nebraska workforce. with an average salary of **\$95,173**.
