

Impact of Federal Government on the Wyoming Economy

Dedicated federal employees serve the American public from coast to coast. The federal employees who live in work in Wyoming are part of the 85% of federal workers who live and work outside of Washington D.C.

In 2024 there were an estimated **10,667** federal employees living in the state, representing **3.6%** of the Wyoming workforce, with an average salary of **\$84,460**.
