



NTEU was instrumental in getting the Telework Enhancement Act signed into law and expanding the use of telework in the federal workforce.

The Telework Enhancement Act...

- authorizes all eligible federal employees to telework.
- mandates that agencies develop detailed telework plans as well as workforce training programs.
- requires agencies to incorporate telework into contingency plans for use during bad weather, natural disasters and other emergencies.
- prepares the federal government for the future.

Additionally,

- NTEU works to bargain maximum eligibility for as many job series and positions as we can, along with removing barriers (such as assertions of work not being portable).
- NTEU has a proven track record of success in enforcing our contractual rights to telework.
- NTEU's efforts in pushing maximum telework capabilities for employees over the years greatly benefitted agencies with employees we represent because it meant those agencies were able to quickly pivot when the pandemic hit to a largely virtual environment.

- Since the start of the pandemic, NTEU has been pressing agencies to take the necessary steps to protect you and your families, provide you with adequate resources for telework and accommodate your personal needs and situations.
