Voting is one of the most powerful ways to make your voice heard in our democracy, but in 2020, only 66.8% of the voting-age population in the United States reported voting.

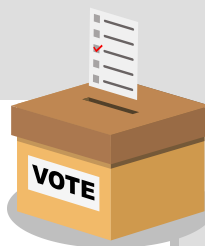
Modern technology has improved access to information on candidates and made it easier to register to vote in many areas, and it is vital to be aware of how you can participate in the 2024 election cycle.



## SOUTH DAKOTA'S ABSENTEE AND MAIL-IN VOTING PROCEDURES

### Permanent absentee/ mail-in voting procedures:

- No excuse required to request an absentee ballot
- Applications can be submitted via mail



## SOUTH DAKOTA'S EARLY VOTING DEADLINES

Early Voting **Begins: September 20**

Early Voting **Ends: November 4**

## DEADLINES TO KNOW FOR VOTING IN SOUTH DAKOTA



### VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINE:

**October 21**

Fifteen days before an election.



### ABSENTEE / MAIL-IN VOTING BALLOT DEADLINES:

Request must be received by

**November 4**

One day before the election at 5 PM.



### BALLOT SUBMISSION DEADLINE:

Must be received by 7 PM on Election Day.  
Mail Receipt by Election Day

## HOW CAN YOU REGISTER TO VOTE IN SOUTH DAKOTA

To register to vote in South Dakota, visit the State Board of Elections website for more information on voter eligibility and the registration process.
