Dear Senator:

As National President of the National Treasury Employees Union, representing over 150,000 federal employees in 32 different agencies, I am writing to urge Congress to act to ensure federal employees are paid on time, and on legislation to guarantee that all federal employees are paid as quickly as possible following a shutdown.

Federal employees work and live in every district and state in the country, and are proud to work for the federal government. They perform a multitude of jobs, including working as scientists, accountants, engineers, inspectors, and law enforcement. The possibility of another government shutdown is making employees and their families nervous as a shutdown would result in hundreds of thousands of Americans being furloughed or working without receiving a paycheck. These employees and their families depend on their paychecks. And it's not just federal workers who are impacted—local economies and small businesses also suffer in the event of a shutdown.

Legislation has been introduced in the House and Senate, H.R. 4827 and S. 2274, to ensure that federal employees are paid in the event of a government shutdown. I urge you to support these important bills and ensure that federal workers receive their pay.
