


# Tired of clicking on cars and street signs when logging into NTEU.org?

## Here's a tip that can help limit that security feature.

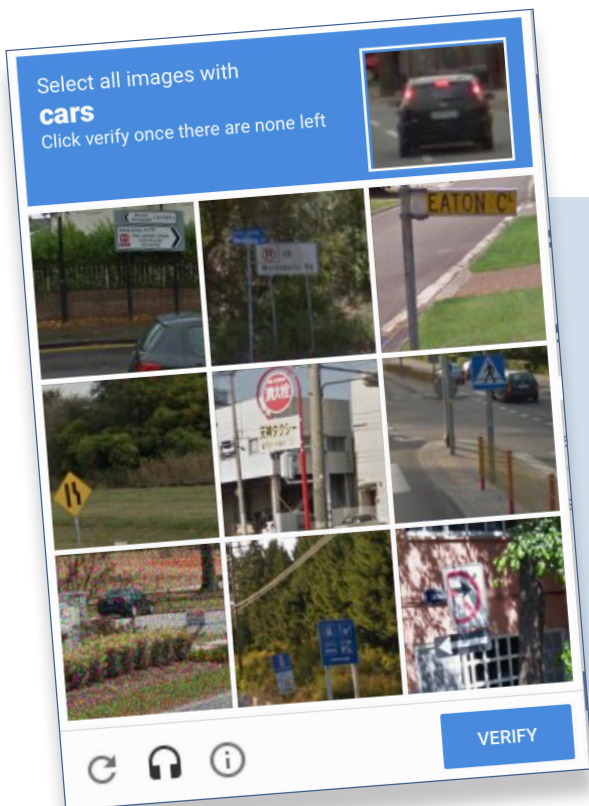


The screenshot shows the login form with the following fields and options:

Check the **“Remember Me”** box after filling in your username and password. As long as you log in from the same device and browser and don't log out, the security features will verify you without clicking through any pictures.



## Why have the pictures at all?

The security measure is called ReCAPTCHA and it is one of the most robust security measures available. NTEU uses it for your protection. There is personal information on our site that the union must protect. ReCAPTCHA works to prevent bots from hacking into the site and giving an Internet troll access to your information.

**One more tip:** create a password that is difficult to crack. The most secure passwords are eight or more characters with at least one number, two uppercase letters and two lowercase letters.
